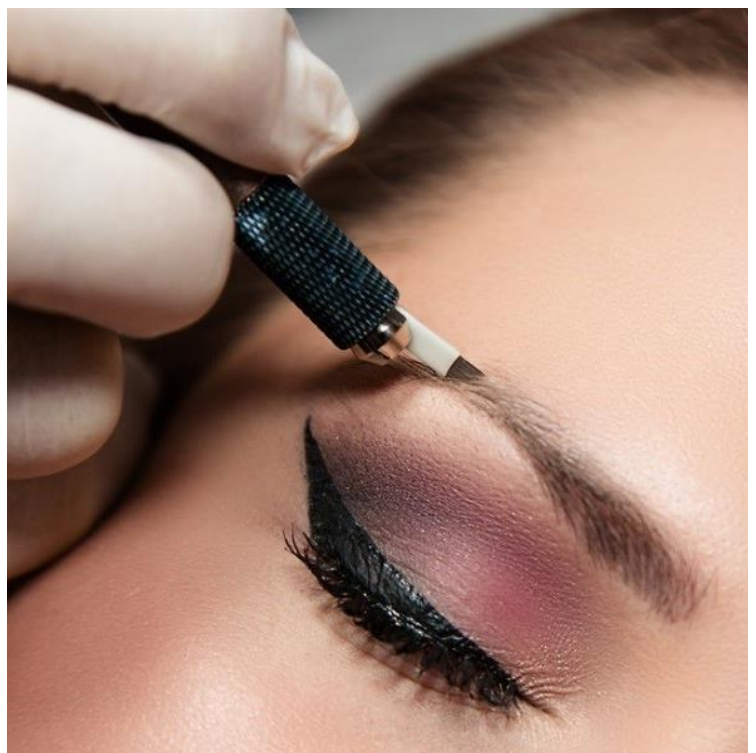

The Microblade technique does not involve a machine but tiny micro blades on a hand-held tool which, together with our organic pigment range, offers an alternative brow enhancement treatment. Micro bladed brows have a unique hair stroke look and we teach a very natural European look to enhance your clients' features.

You will be able to offer the fuller, more defined brows which are so in vogue now. Students who do not hold a recognized make-up certificate are required to attend our Essential Make-up Workshop prior to commencing their training. Proof of qualifications is required.

Course Content

1. Anatomy & Physiology: The skin, face, lymph system and immune system
2. Health, Safety & Salon Hygiene: Your duty of care, regulations, licensing, sterilization, disinfection & needle disposal
3. Client Care
4. Client Consultation: Managing expectations, contraindications, record keeping, patch testing, medical issues to consider, pain control, after care and follow up treatments.
5. Equipment: Getting to know the tools, blade choice, and additional equipment required for treatments, setting up your work area
6. Color Theory: Identifying skin tones, choosing colors and tones, mixing colors, controlling color performance in the skin, working on ethnic skin types.
7. Pain Control: Legal options available and their application
8. Perfect brow positioning: How to measure and position the brows
9. Treatment application: Enhancing thin brows, creating natural hair strokes, color blending.
10. Sales & Aftercare
11. Marketing

Course Layout

- Segments will be emailed to you together with videos. The assessments can be sent to your tutor's email address.
- **Day 1:** Recap of Theory, Practice on 'practice skin' and 1 model with no previous eyebrow permanent makeup.
4 weeks after initial training
- **Day 2:** 2 or 3 models required for the day.
- **Half Day:** Infill class, a previous model used that can be used to do a fill on this day.
- **Submitted Online**
- Exam includes a half day portfolio review and copies of case studies must be submitted online **before** the final exam day.
- **Day 3: Mock, Theory and Final Exam Day:**
 - Theory – it is a closed book exam and 85% pass rate required.
 - Mock Exam – a model with no previous eyebrow permanent makeup.
 - Final Exam – a model with no previous eyebrow permanent makeup and 85 % pass rate required.
