Qualification Fee: R46 500 includes training fee and kit (compulsory products).

This course is designed for complete beginners, qualified beauty therapists and medical professionals. Students who do not hold a recognized make-up certificate are required to attend our Essential Make-up Workshop prior to commencing their training. Proof of qualification is required.
