2. Health, Safety & Salon Hygiene: Your duty of care, regulations, licensing, sterilization, disinfection & needle disposal

4. Client Consultation: Managing expectations, contraindications, record keeping, patch testing, medical issues to consider, pain control, after care and follow up treatments.
5. Equipment: Getting to know the tools, blade choice, and additional equipment required for treatments, setting up your work area
6. Color Theory: Identifying skin tones, choosing colors and tones, mixing colors, controlling color performance in the skin, working on ethnic skin types.
7. Pain Control: Legal options available and their application
8. Perfect brow positioning: How to measure and position the brows
9. Treatment application: Enhancing thin brows, creating natural hair strokes, color blending.

## COURSE LAYOUT

- Once we receive payment the Manuals and case study material and videos will be emailed to the student. Answers and assignments can be emailed to karen@lcn.co.za. It is important that you complete all theory before attending the practical classes.
  - **Day 1: Practical Full Day**
    - Recap of theory, measuring eyebrows and practice on one another measuring techniques. Practice on the 'practice skin'.
    - Please note models should not have had previous PMU.
  - **Day 2: Practical Full Day**
    - 3 models required for the day.
  - **Day 3: Practical Full Day**
    - 3 models required for the day.
- **4 weeks after initial training**
  - **Day 4: Mock & Theory Exam Half Day**
    - Assisted class with 1 model, no previous eyebrow PMU.
    - Final theory paper to be written.
  - **Day 5: Half day**
    - Final model with no previous PMU on eyebrows.
    - Case studies to be submitted and result of theory and practical exam discussed.
